- Shared Town Update from Sam Pierce
 - Several Resolutions before the Town Board at the 11/29 Meeting.
 - Request for Speed Study on Buffalo St Extension-Resident concern with traffic coming over hill and cross walk entering Outhouse Park. Parks and Rec in support of the request to the State for a Speed Study in this area.
 - Thank you to Assemblyman Kolb & Senator Helming for their help in securing the transfer of Lower Onanda Park to the Town of Canandaigua. Parks members also wish to extend a thank you to both.
 - Resolution authorizing Doug to work with NYS to execute the necessary documents to transfer ownership of Lower Onanda to the Town.
 - Resolution for Town to enter into an option to purchase land for a new town park and public access to Canandaigua Lake. Parks and Rec members all expressed their support for this Resolution. Great opportunity for the Town and is inline with the goals generated in the 2018 Parks Master Plan related to lake access and the development of new trails within the Town.
- Planning work continues at Outhouse West.
 - Meeting with Town officials, RMB, and Inclusive Playground members to coordinate efforts and address design concerns scheduled for Nov. 4th. Link will be sent out with Zoom meeting details.
- Auburn Trail Update
 - Consultants still plugging away on Trail planning and securing easements. Fisher Associated currently working to resolve issues involving a cross walk across County Route 30.
- Uplands at Onanda
 - Litanhi still in need of repairs. Possibility still exists to work to be done this fall.
 Determination needs to be made if it makes more sense to repair or is it time to look at replacement? Prefab with upgrades to make more attractive to potential renters?
 - Committee asked to visit the uplands and think about possible improvements to access roads, buildings and trails.

- Park Security
 - Recent vandalism at Parks. Most notably Outhouse Park. Investigating the installation of security cameras to deter. Recent Internet upgrades should benefit these efforts.
- Arts and Crafts Building @ Onanda
 - Parks staff working at cleaning and organizing the space. Plan to create a usable activities area for cabin renters and Park Staff.
- Sarah Reynolds shared addition Town Updates
 - CIC working to finalize details around new Comp Plan.
 - Tree Committee providing valuable information about and addressing needs of the many trees found in the Town Parks and Cemeteries.
