ACCEPTED ITEMS: Zero-Sort™ RECYCLING

Deposit all CLEAN and EMPTY recyclables, with caps and lids on, into the recycling compactor.



Newspapers, magazines,
and store flyers



Envelopes and junk mail



Office paper (white and colored)
and file folders



Corrugated cardboard



Box board (cereal boxes, paper
egg cartons, empty rolls, etc.)



Glass bottles and jars
(all colors)



Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs,
and lids



Empty food cans and aluminum foil



NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING: JUST JUNK IT

The following items are NOT accepted for recycling and should be disposed of with household trash.



Plastic and paper cups



Ceramics



Paper towels or facial tissue



Notebooks with metal or plastic binding attached



VCR tapes, CDs, and DVDs



Drinking glasses and tempered glassware (Pyrex)



Window and auto glass



Picture frame glass



Automotive fluid containers



Aerosol cans



Styrofoam

SPECIAL COLLECTION ITEMS

Put these items in their separate designated collection area at the Transfer Station.



Food and organic waste (composting)



Leaves, brush, Christmas trees, and yard debris



Plastic bags



Gently used clothes and other textiles



Appliances (small and large) and scrap metal



Used motor oil



Batteries: car, truck, boat, motorcycle, and lawn tractor batteries; single use AA, AAA, D, C



Electronics



Construction and demolition debris



Furniture, mattresses, and carpets



Fluorescent bulbs

RECYCLE YOUR ELECTRONICS

Deposit these items in the electronics recycling area at the Transfer Station.



Telephones and cell phones



Stereos/radios and speakers



Computer tower/desktop, printers, and laptops



MP3 players, iPods, tablets, and iPads



Cables/IT accessories, routers/modems, and gaming consoles



Computer monitors, CRT, and flat-panel televisions

FOOD WASTE DIVERSION

Put these items in your food and organics recycling bucket.



Paper towels, napkins, and shredded paper



Approved compostable materials only; must be labeled ASTM D6400



Cereal, bread, and baked goods



Pasta, rice, and other grain products



Fruit and vegetable scraps



Eggshells, bones, and shellfish



Coffee grounds, filters, and tea bags



Meat, poultry, and seafood products



Dairy products



Used cooking oil and bacon grease (small quantities only)



Please be sure not to contaminate the contents with:

- ⊗ Aluminum foil or metal
- ⊗ Bottles or cans
- ⊗ Hazardous waste
- ⊗ Milk or dairy cartons
- ⊗ Plastic bags
- ⊗ Straws
- ⊗ Textiles
- ⊗ Styrofoam
- ⊗ Wood or sawdust
- ⊗ Wrappers



PLASTIC BAG AND FILM RECYCLING

Accepted materials must be CLEAN and DRY.



Plastic shopping bags



Cereal/cracker box liners



Produce bags



Zip-type food storage bags



Bath tissue and paper towel wrap



Bubble wrap and shipping pillows



Bread bags



Case wraps (ex. around water bottles)



Dry cleaning bags



Clean plastic wrap



Not acceptable types:

- ⊗ Biodegradable bags
- ⊗ Candy wrappers
- ⊗ Chip bags
- ⊗ Frozen food bags
- ⊗ Pet food bags
- ⊗ Resealable pouches
- ⊗ Reusable bags
- ⊗ Salad mix bags
- ⊗ Soiled garbage bags
- ⊗ Water softener salt bags

Coupons: Some items require the purchase of coupons for disposal or recycling.

Coupons are available to Town residents at the Transfer Station (cash only), or from the Town Clerk weekdays 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM and with extended hours on Wednesdays to 7:00 PM.



Permits: Use of the Transfer Station is available by permit only for Town of Canandaigua residents. Permits are available from the Town Clerk's office at Town Hall with proof of residency. Registration is needed for any vehicle using the facility.
