TOWN OF CANANDAIGUA LOCAL LAW # OF 2017

ATTACHMENT "A"

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Canandaigua as follows:

SECTION ONE. The definition of "ACCESSORY BUILDING" contained in Town Code § 1-17 shall be replaced in its entirety with the following:

ACCESSORY BUILDING

A building, as defined in this section, that is subordinate and incidental to the principal building or structure on the same lot, contributes to the comfort, convenience, or necessity of the occupants of the principal building or structure, and is used for a purpose incidental to the use of the principal building or structure. Accessory buildings include but are not limited to storage sheds, nonagricultural barns, and detached private garages.

ACCESSORY STRUCTURE

A structure, but not including buildings, subordinate and incidental to the principal building or structure on the same lot, that contributes to the comfort, convenience, or necessity of the occupants of the principal building or structure and that is used for a purpose incidental to the use of the principal building or structure. Accessory structures include but are not limited to swimming pools, tennis courts, basketball courts, paddleball courts, patios, decks, generators, and fences. Accessory Structures shall not include fences for setback purposes.

SECTION TWO. Town Code § 220-9(B)(1) shall be replaced in its entirety with the following:

An accessory building attached to a principal building shall be considered a part of the principal building and is required to comply with the yard requirements of this chapter for the principal building. For the purposes of this section, "attached" shall mean physical connection by way of a common wall or foundation and not separated by an unenclosed exterior space.

SECTION THREE. Partial Invalidity. If any provision of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Local Law, but shall be confined in its operation to the provision, person, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION FOUR. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
