


2014 Annual Report for NYS Electronic Waste Collection Sites

(January 1 - December 31, 2014 Reporting Period)
Due: March 1, 2015



In accordance with the New York State Electronic Equipment Recycling and Reuse Act (Environmental Conservation Law, Article 27, Title 26), this annual report form must be completed for each registered electronic waste collection site located in the state, and submitted to the Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) annually by March 1st for the previous calendar year. Failure to submit a complete and timely annual report, including the appropriate signatures, will subject the electronic waste collection site to civil penalties under the Act.

Retail collection sites which have registered under one registration number may submit one combined annual report, provided they report all required information collectively and attach a list of retail site names and addresses for each location represented.

Electronic waste collection sites must also maintain all supporting documentation regarding the management of electronic waste (e.g. registration/reporting forms, shipping invoices, bills of lading, etc.) on-site for a period of three years for data verification purposes.

A "premium service" means any service above and beyond the reasonably convenient acceptance methods defined in the Act. These include equipment and data security services, refurbishment for reuse by the consumer, and other custom services such as at-home collection (other than mail back programs), data wiping, specialized packing and preparation for collection, etc.
