In accordance with Town of Canandaigua Town Code §17-5 the Town of Canandaigua Agricultural Advisory Committee (Ag Committee) met on June 6, 2019 to review and provide comment relative to the four applications listed below and referred to the Ag Committee by the PRC. The applications and the Ag Committee's findings are as follows.

Venezia Group LLC, representing DAGR Group LLC, owner of property west **of County Road 16 TM #97.04-2-100.100, TM #97.04-1-6.121, TM#97.04-2-101.000** Requesting Sketch Plan review for Ashton South and Fox Ridge Combined (Lacrosse Circle/Lake Breeze Way/Bedford Drive Extension).

Review was based on:

- Application materials on file as of 6/6/19
- Ontario County On-Cor maps
- Maps and Parcel Ranking data in the 2016 Agricultural Enhancement Plan
- Maps and Parcel Ranking data in the 2018 Open Space, Conservation, and Scenic Views Master Plan
- Town policies and maps incorporated in Comprehensive Plan and Land Use Planning documents adopted by Town Board.

Findings:

- 1. This application consists of a sketch plan proposing 70 single-family homes on 70 lots on three parcels situated between Ashton South and Fox Ridge subdivisions that would connect Ashton Place/Bedford Drive with Lake Breeze Way and LaCrosse Circle.
- 2. The parcels are NOT located within Ontario County Ag District 1
- 3. Property is NOT currently farmed
- 4. **97.04-2-100.100** consists of the following soil types:
 - a. Honeoye loam, 3 to 8 percent slopes 43.9%, 6.2 Prime Farmland
 - b. Honeoye loam, 8 to 15 percent slopes 30.0%, 4.2 acres Statewide Importance
 - c. Honeoye loam, 15 to 25 percent slopes 0.0%, 0.0 acres Not Prime
 - d. Lima loam, 3 to 8 percent slopes 26.0%, 3.7 acres Prime Farmland
- 5. **97.04-2-101.000** consists of the following soil types:

- a. Honeoye loam, 3 to 8 percent slopes 33.0%, 2.8 acres Prime Farmland
- b. Honeoye loam, 8 to 15 percent slopes 23.8%, 2.0 acres Statewide Importance
- c. Honeoye loam, 15 to 25 percent slopes 43.2%, 3.6 acres Not Prime
- 6. **97.04-1-6.121** consists of the following soil types:
 - a. Honeoye loam, 3 to 8 percent slopes 37.9%, 16.7 acres Prime Farmland
 - b. Honeoye loam, 8 to 15 percent slopes 30.2%, 13.3 acres Statewide Importance
 - c. Honeoye loam, 15 to 25 percent slopes 5.7%, 2.5 acres Not Prime
 - d. Lima loam, 3 to 8 percent slopes 23.4%, 10.3 acres Prime Farmland
 - e. Ovid silt loam, 0 to 3 percent slopes 2.7%, 1.2 acres Prime if Drained
- 7. Parcels did NOT receive a rating from Ag Enhancement Plan
- 8. Parcels LOW and MODERATE ratings from the Open Space Master Plan
- 9. Parcel is NOT in the Padelford Brook Greenway
- 10. Parcel is NOT in the Strategic Farmland Protection Area
- 11. Parcel is NOT in the Strategic Forest Protection Area

Comments

- 1. The Agricultural Advisory Committee recommends that prior to approval or disapproval of the project, the Planning Board require the necessary studies to ensure that drainage resulting from this development be properly managed and mitigated.
- 2. The Committee recommends that the loss of wildlife habitat be considered prior to the approval or disapproval of this project.
