It has been brought to my attention that Mr. Reiser has stated that my comments regarding the aerobic system at 5265 are "simply not true".

For the record, what I stated was that Mr. Reiser has never supplied an a copy of the contract with a wastewater system maintenance company to the Watershed Inspector as required, nor have they supplied the twice yearly reports of such maintenance company. No one cares whether he has supplied the contract to his own project manager. Copies of the contract and the bi-yearly reports are supposed to go to the Watershed Inspector, so that they can be monitored and so that the Watershed Inspector has a complete picture of everything that can affect the health of the lake. The fact that eI am correct, and that this has not been done as I stated can be verified by reading the letter in the file written by the Watershed Inspector regarding the subject property dated 1/10/17.
