

In meeting with neighbors, in the area of North and Andrews Roads, they welcomed receiving accurate information about the proposed solar garden. Several commented that they had heard other information and had assumed that the solar garden would be very visible, similar to one nearby.

During our visits we provided the neighbors with an informational letter about the project, had enhanced photos for them to view of the proposed project, and discussed the benefits of the Community Shared Solar Garden. We shared that the system would be not be installed in the fields or close to the roads; that it would be tucked into the scrub area surrounded by three sides of existing trees, shrubs, and wetlands and additional flowering tree and shrub buffers would be planted to restrict the view. We also discussed that there would be a 4ft wire livestock fence and wood rail fence similar to the existing horse paddocks and not a chain link fence.
