Chris,

Peter German and I attended the hearing of the Regional Board of Review in Williamsville yesterday for the variance request the Marina had made for the elimination of the fire sprinklers within the two proposed storage buildings on North Road. The Board granted the variance with the following conditions:

- 1. A three hour fire barrier separate the repair shop from the storage area of building #1.
- 2. Heat sensitive skylights be used in the roof so they will drop out in the event of a fire to vent heat and smoke.
- 3. The 2 fire hydrants shown on the site plans be installed.
- 4. The aerial fire apparatus road shown on the site plan be installed.
- 5. The batteries be removed from boats stored in the buildings.
- 6. A three hour fire barrier be installed to divide the storage areas into approximately two equal parts.
- 7. Heat detection will be provided throughout the storage areas.

We had proposed conditions 1-5 and 7 in the petition and the Board added condition #6. We have forwarded this to the architect so that they can begin to prepare the permit plans to reflect the Board's decision. Given the current staffing and work load at the DOS Codes division the written determination may take 6-8 weeks, if not longer. I am certain the owner would like to proceed ASAP as they were hoping to utilize the facility this year.
