a. Purpose of the proposed project:

This project will replace the existing overflow pipe that was installed in 1976 with the involvement of DEC. The pipe has collapsed in several locations. The pipe will manage the wetlands high water level utilizing a controlled flow from the wetlands into Canandaigua Lake. This will control the wetlands water level to provide capacity to accommodate severe weather water events. The existing pipe is the only drainage out of the CL-13 wetlands.

b. Description of current site conditions:

The current site is on private property located between the NYS CL-13 wetlands and Canandaigua Lake. No trees will be removed.

c. Proposed site changes:

There are no proposed changes to the site other than the pipe replacement and re-grading.

d. Type of structures and fill materials to be installed, and quantity of materials to be used (e.g., square feet of coverage, cubic yards of fill material, structures below ordinary/mean high water, etc.):

Construction will utilize 240 ft of 15 inch double wall culvert pipe. The project will not require any additional fill in that existing soil will be reused as fill. No crushed stone is required in that the pipe is solid wall.

e. Area of excavation or dredging, volume of material to be removed, location of dredged material placement:

Since an existing pipe is being replaced, the expectation is that there will be little excess material to relocate.

g. Work methods and type of equipment to be used:

A small backhoe with front blade will be utilized to dig trench 2 ft wide to remove existing pipe, lay the new pipe and regrade.

h. Describe the planned sequence of activities:

Utilities will be located, remove 2 sections of post and beam fence, remove one bush (to be replanted), dig trench, remove existing pipe, lay replacement pipe, backfill, re-grade, reinstall fence posts, reseed lawn.

i. Pollution control methods and other actions proposed to mitigate environmental impacts:

No pollution creating activities are involved.

j. Erosion and silt control methods that will be used to prevent water quality impacts:

Work will be done in the fall when the lake and wetlands are at their lowest level. It is expected that the wetlands and lake levels will be below the excavation and pipe outlet level. Will utilize erosion fence and or filter material at both ends of pipe construction as required.

k. Alternatives considered to avoid regulated areas. If no feasible alternatives exist, explain how the project will minimize impacts:

This pipe is the only drainage out of the wetlands. There are three designated water drainage areas that feed into the wetlands. There are no other alternatives other than locating the replacement pipe in an alternate location.
