I am available to discuss.

In regards to the stream setback. The comments will be considered by Town Engineering and the Planning Board.

But in the official Zoning Law Determination.. our office will base our determination on DEC mapping in regards to the 100ft. required stream setback. Our code reads "100 feet of the bed of a stream carrying water on an average of six months of the year".

When visiting the site.. I could did not make the determination the swales were indeed streams and carry water 6 months of the year. Our determination will be that they are stormwater/runoff/drainage swales. DEC mapping details the 'blue-line' stream not starting until outside of the parcel.

This is not to say the Boards may require the applicant to stay 100ft. from the swales. It is simply a preliminary determination we will not seek the applicant to apply for variances for stream setback.

In regards to the possible wetlands. We would recommend the applicant complete a wetland investigation and delineation if required.
