Thank you for requesting the comments of the New York State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). We have reviewed the submitted materials in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966. These comments are those of the SHPO and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources.

We have reviewed the Phase I (IA & B) Cultural Resource Investigation report prepared by Powers Archaeology LLC (Powers, July 13, 2021; 21SR00419) in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation Law). OPRHP concurs with the report recommendation that no additional archaeological investigation is warranted.

It is OPRHP's opinion that the project will result in No Effect on historic properties, including archaeological and/or historic resources, listed in or eligible for the New York State and National Registers of Historic Places.
