Thank you for sending me the plans for the work to occur on Route 364. This being the site of the old Lincoln Hill Inn, I looked at our record plans from when the State did a highway job in 1994. At that time, we actually paved their driveway, though left it substandard on width, for reasons unknown. The standard now for a commercial driveway is 24' wide in a one lane in, one lane out configuration. They are proposing a 24' wide throat width driveway, which is acceptable to the NYSDOT. Seeing that there was a commercial establishment there previously, and is proposed to be a commercial establishment, we concur with what they are proposing for a driveway width. Radii size does seem too small though. A highway work permit, PERM 33, type 5b2c, would be required to widen that driveway and subsequent gutter work, as the standard for gutter has it flare out at a driveway, the entire width. A permit like that would be approved in my office and if the owner has any questions, I can be reached at the address and phone number below.
