NUTRIENT LOADING AND WATER QUALITY IN THE FINGER LAKES

PRESENTED JOHN HALFMAN,

BY PROFESSOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

WATER QUALITY IN A NUMBER OF THE FINGER LAKES HAS DECLINED OVER THE PAST DECADE. DR. HALFMAN WILL DISCUSS WATER QUALITY INDICATORS AND THEIR DECADE-SCALE CHANGES. HE WILL INCLUDE EVIDENCE FROM CANANDAIGUA AND NEIGHBORING WATER-SHEDS THAT LINKS NUTRIENT LOADING TO WATER QUALITY.

PROFESSOR HALFMAN HAS TAUGHT AT HWS SINCE 1994. HE WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FINGER LAKES INSTITUTE. HE HAS RESEARCHED WATER QUALITY ISSUES IN LAKE SUPERIOR AND EAST AFRICAN RIFT LAKE; HIS CURRENT RESEARCH INTERESTS ARE THE FINGER LAKES. PROFESSOR HALFMAN HAS HIS B.S. FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI, HIS M.S. FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA AND HIS PH.D. FROM DUKE UNIVERSITY.
