

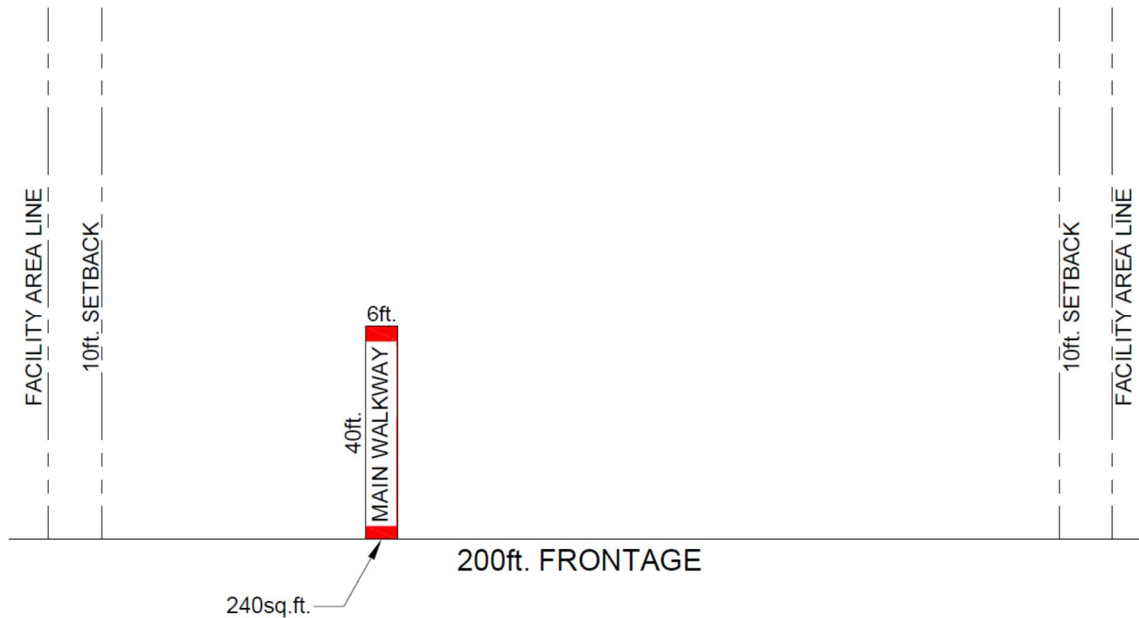
MAIN WALKWAY

The section of the dock that extends from the mean high-water mark toward the center of the lake.

APPENDAGE

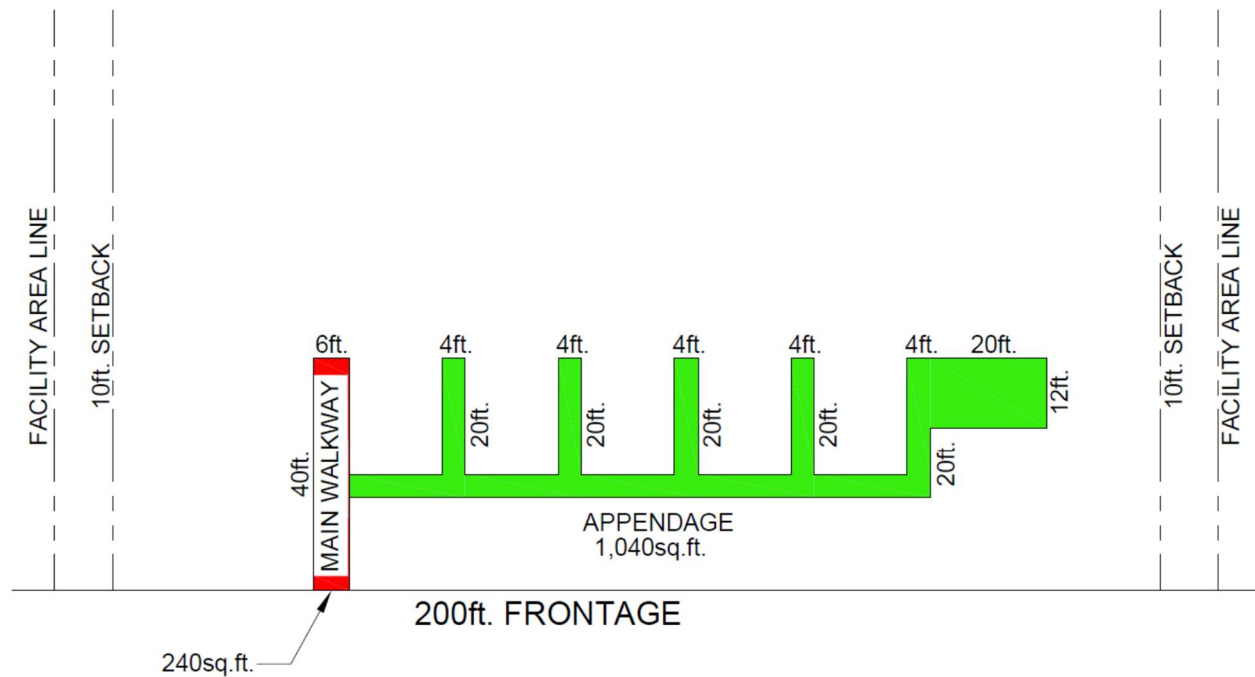
The portion of the dock that is attached to the main walkway.

96-9 C. (1) (a) The main walkway of the dock is the section of the dock that extends from the mean high-water mark toward the center of the lake. The main walkway shall not exceed a maximum width of eight feet.



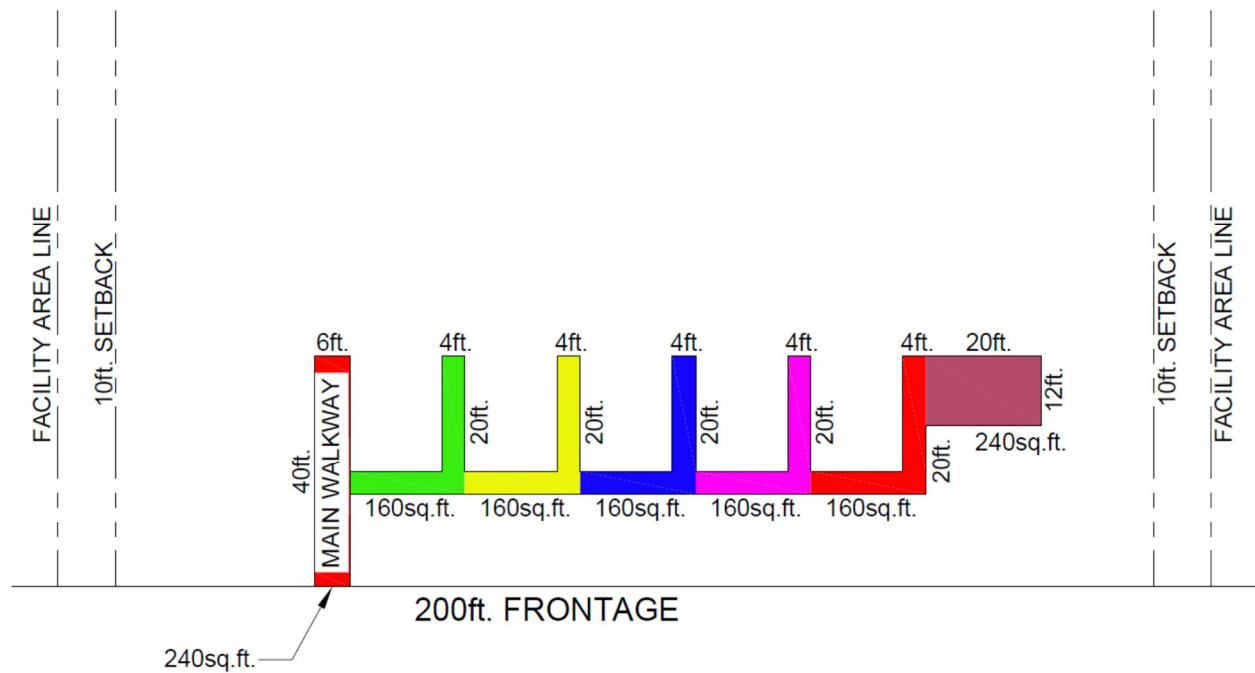
96-9 C. (1) (f) Any appendage shall not exceed a total area of 256 square feet.

Is this dock configuration permissible?



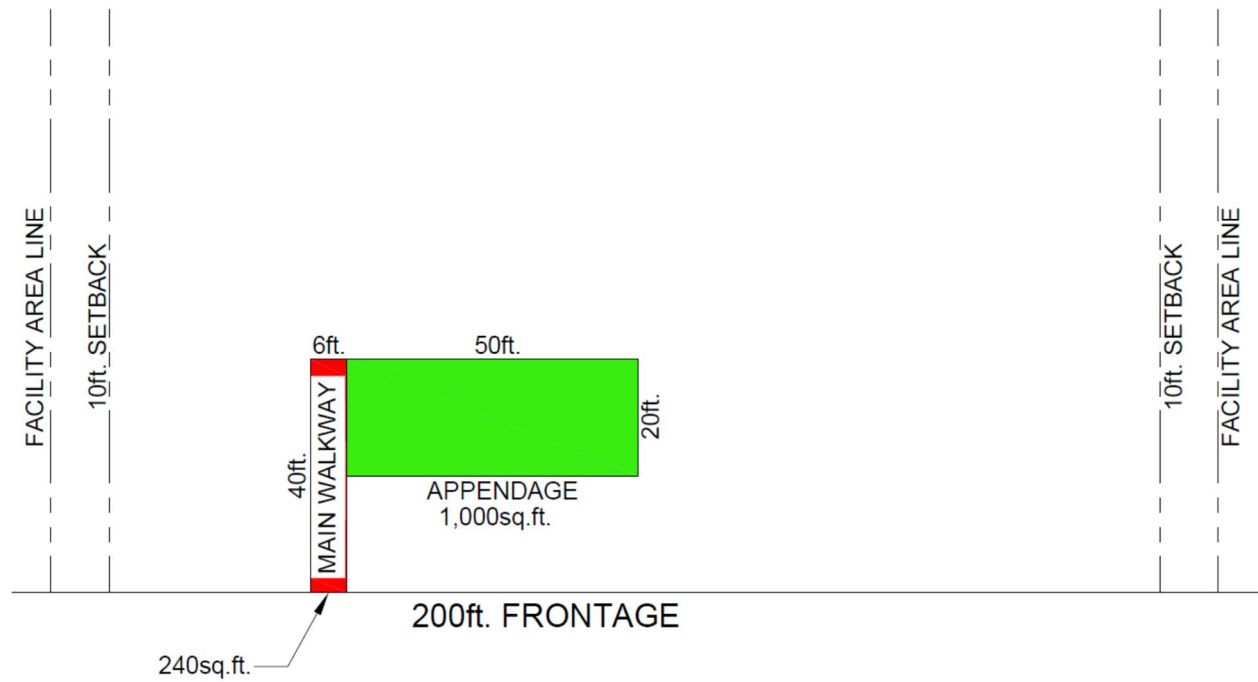
No. The appendage exceeds 256sq.ft.

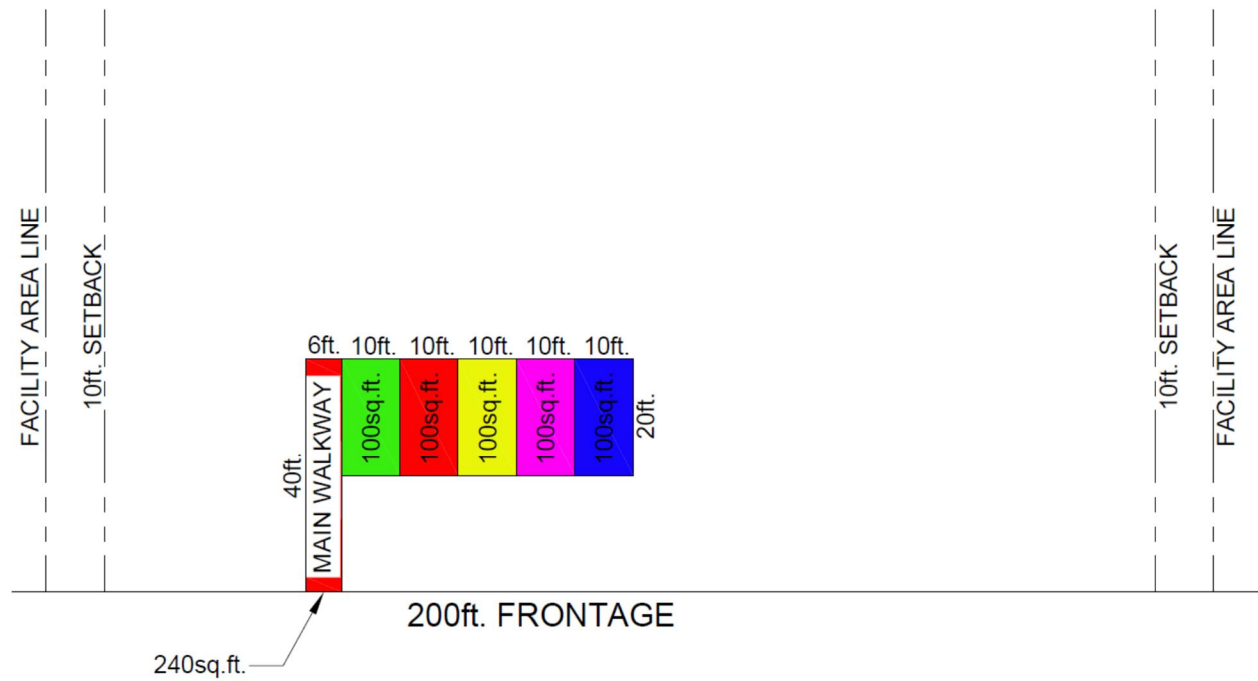
Is this dock permissible? No. It is the same dock configuration.
