# <u>RESOLUTION NO. 2015 – 243: ONTARIO COUNTY SNOW REMOVAL CONTRACT</u> AMENDMENT

**WHEREAS**, on October 19, 2015 the Canandaigua Town Board entered into an Agreement with Ontario County for snow removal pursuant to Resolution 2015-249; and

**WHEREAS**, the actual costs of snow and ice control services may be in excess of the rate set by Ontario County Resolution 625-2015; and

**WHEREAS**, Ontario County has provided an amendment to the agreement (Attachment 1) allowing for an additional payment of \$800 per center-line mile contingent upon the Town executing the agreement and other conditions as noted on the amendment; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IS RESOLVED**, the Town of Canandaigua hereby approves of the terms of the Amendment and directs the Town Supervisor to take the necessary action to execute said agreement; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Town Clerk is hereby directed to return 3 fully executed copies of the Agreement and the Amendment to the Ontario County Administrator's Office, 20 Ontario Street, Canandaigua, NY 14424 prior to October 30, 2015.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2015 – 244: HICKOX ROAD WATER DISTRICT**
