The Town Board seeks comments on the “Uptown Canandaigua Mixed Use and Transportation Corridor Feasibility Study” (“Uptown Study”) prepared by Bergmann Associates.

The Uptown Study will provide a sustainable multi-modal transportation development plan. The study will encompass the area bounded by North Street north to Thomas/Emerson Road and from the Airport west of State Route 332 to County Road 28, and North Road to Canandaigua Academy. The anticipated outcomes should include options for improving sustainable transportation options, including: walking, biking, and public transportation.
