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BUILDING A HOUSE IN THE TOWN OF CANANDAIGUA

When applying for a building permit you will need the following:

- 1. Completed "New House" or "Tear Down / Rebuild House" Permit Application.
- 2. Completed Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Permit Application.
- 3. Approved septic system design from a professional engineer or from the Ontario County Soil and Water Conservation District office.
- 4. Water information:
 - a. Public water from:
 - The Canandaigua Water District;
 - The Canandaigua-Farmington Water District; or,
 - The Canandaigua-Hopewell Water District
 - b. Private well NY State well digger certification required.
- 5. Site Plan showing location of driveway, new structures complete with setbacks, septic and well locations, stream beds, etc.
- 6. Two (2) wet stamped sets of house blueprints that include:
 - Height of the new house from the average finished grade
 - House elevations shown from the north, south, east, and west
 - Floor plans
 - Wall sections / footings / framing
 - Truss drawings/roof system layout including all bracing patterns
 - Joist/Truss Joist / I-Joist system layout including all bracing patterns
 - Window and door schedule including egress specifications
 - Fireplace specifications, if applicable
 - Energy calculations (We recommend submitting this using REScheck software)
 - HVAC, electrical, plumbing, and finishing details
 - Location of all smoke and Carbon monoxide detectors
- 7. Insurance Certificates for Contractor with Town of Canandaigua as Certificate Holder:
 - *NY State form* showing current workers compensation coverage, and
 - *NY State form* showing current disability coverage.
- 8. An instrument survey showing the location and setbacks of all structures on the property is required for Certificate of Occupancy.
