Depart for **Fly Creek Cider Mill**, with free time to shop, browse and sample delicious apple cider with your included marketplace voucher. Dinner will be on your own in downtown **Cooperstown**, before check-in at the Courtyard by Marriott Cooperstown/Oneonta.
